## WINEMAKER'S COMMENTS

### COLOUR:

Deep, bright ruby-red with hints of purple.

### NOSE:

Intense and fresh, its fruit is typical with strawberry, black fruit and scented flowers, e.g.iris and tulip on the back nose.

### PALATE:

On the palate, it is big and full-fleshed with a very good, well balanced body.

### SERVING SUGGESTION:

On its own for party drinking, otherwise with hot of cold charcuterie and poultry.
